## Introduction

This is a very easy and very fun game that can be played with kids and adults at the same time.

## Equipment Needed

- 6 to 12 People
- 6 dice
- 6 quarters per person
- Or poker chips


## Win Condition

Be the last person with quarters.

## Setup

Place a big bowl in the middle of the table.

## How to Play

A player rolls as 1 dice for each quarter they have, up to 6 dice. You move your quarters to other players, or out of the game, depending on what you roll.

- Give 1 quarter to the player on the left for each 4
- Place 1 quarter in the bowl for each 5
- Give 1 quarter to the player on the right for each 6
- $1 \mathrm{~s}, 2 \mathrm{~s}$, and 3 s don't do anything

Then pass the dice to the player on the left to do the same thing.
When it's your turn again, if you have only 3 quarters, then you roll only 3 dice. If you have 8 quarters, you roll the max of 6 dice.

If a player is passed the dice who does not have any quarters, they lose their turn and simply pass the dice on. They are still in the game though as they could potentially get a quarter later on.

## Winning

At some point, most of the quarters will be in the bowl and there will only be 2 players left. When all players are eliminated but 1, that player is the winner and gets to keep all the quarters.
